A YEAR IN REVIEW- 2021 AND GREENLEAF

We take great pride in doing everything we can to better the lives of our participants. That's why, as a company, Greenleaf holds itself to high standards by setting goals to achieve throughout the year. We faced many changes this year with COVID and restructuring to a non-profit but came out better for it. Greenleaf saw an amazing year of empowering our participants and helping as many people in our community as possible.

In 2021, we had a total of 595 people referred to us for various services throughout this year. We provided pre-employment services, like Summer Youth, Community Based Assessments, and Career Exploration as well as our most popular job development and job coaching services.

We found participants 137 jobs in 2021. Job sectors include janitorial/custodial, retail, cooking, warehouse/stocking, child/elder care, pet services, administrative work, teaching, and more. On average, our participants made between \$10 and \$14 an hour at their new jobs. Most importantly, our surveys of employers and participants rate Greenleaf above 4/5 stars on average.

As a non-profit, we confirmed our inaugural board of directors which allowed us to begin setting our budget and make decisions for our future. We've hired a Development Manager to head our outreach to community partners and begin looking for grant opportunities. Look out for new program offerings funded by grants and donations in the future.

We continue to look forward to providing the best services possible in 2022 as we continue to help any and all who need us.
